In the Beginning...

- God created the heavens, the earth, and all that moves, breaths, and lives upon the ground (Genesis 1)
- There is only ONE God

There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to one hope when you were called—⁵ one Lord, one faith, one baptism; ⁶ one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

 God's most prized creation is man, who was created to have fellowship with Him.

God, Jesus, & the Holy Spirit

God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit make up the Trinity (the Godhead): one entity, one Supreme Being with three distinct functions. The Godhead/Trinity always was. There will never be another created being who will be able to rise above or take the throne of God the Father, God the Son, or God the Holy Spirit.

God, The Father - The Creator of the heavens and the earth. The first in the Godhead and the owner of everything; by His hands all things in heaven and on earth were created. His primary role is Supreme Deity and He is to be worshipped and loved by the creation of His hands.

God, the Son - Jesus is the Son of God. He is the Word of God made flesh and was with God in the beginning and knows how to reach God. His primary role is that of Savior. He was born of a virgin and lived a sinless life; voluntarily submitted to the will of His Father to be the sin offering for the world. He died, was buried, and three days later rose from the dead. He now sits at the right hand of God, interceding for those He died to save.

God, the Holy Spirit - The Holy Spirit was also with God in the beginning for the Spirit of God hovered over the spoken Word and made created life a reality. His primary role is to remind us to worship our Creator, remember the promises of God, and encourage us to walk in the ways of God. He is our Guide and Counselor as we (mankind) travel this road called life.

With a general understanding of who God is, we must now understand the role of mankind and the position we have here on the earth.

Mankind (male & female)

- Mankind, both male and female were created in the image and likeness of God (with 3 distinct functions to our lives we have a spirit, a soul, and a body...just like the Godhead/Trinity).
- Mankind was created for the glory of God, to have fellowship with Him, and to worship Him.
- Mankind is God's perfect creation. We have been given the ability to think, to reason, and to make choices (no other created creature was given this ability).
- Mankind has the ability to choose (or not to choose) to love God and/or believe that He is who He says that He is and to follow the path that He has laid out for life...the path of righteousness.

Angels, Demons, & Lucifer, the Enemy of God

Angels

Angels are created beings with the primary role of worshipping God and doing His bidding. They are the messengers of God who ensure that His will is carried out.

Lucifer, the Enemy of God

(Satan or the devil)

- Lucifer is an angel, a created being. He was not with God in the beginning.
- Lucifer was once the most beautiful created being in the kingdom of God with the primary role of worshipping God (He was in charge of the music of heaven). He was always in the presence of God and in the Throne Room.
- Lucifer was not happy with the role that he had been given, for he wanted to be god and to sit/rule on the Throne of God. It was his desire to rule it all, so he convinced a third of the angelic host to join him in his quest to dethrone God.
- Lucifer's act of rebellion against God caused a war in heaven, which left him (and those who followed him) homeless, without a job or position, and destitute. He became a wanderer and was cast out of heaven; confined to the earth until it is time for him to be judged for his actions.
- Lucifer (now known as the devil/Satan) and the fallen angels (now known as demons) will one day be judged for the evil they committed in heaven. The punishment for their act of rebellion against God will be eternal separation from God, in a designated place created just for them...HELL.

One must wonder why God cast His adversary down to the earth, our home and dwelling place. My personal theory is this: If God had just cast His adversary out of heaven and into the universe, then he (Lucifer) would have had the opportunity to corrupt both the heavens and the earth. Lucifer was confined to a small area to influence and rule for a short time, until his eternal dwelling place could be made ready for his time of judgment. He cannot get off the earth or away from those who worship God (this is a temporal form of punishment). Once his punishment has been handed down, he will be confined to a much smaller area away from God for all eternity.

<u>Hell</u>

- Hell was created for Lucifer (a fallen angel and adversary of God) and one-third of the angels who followed his lead (now called demons) as their eternal dwelling place for their decision to usurp the authority and rule of God.
- Hell is described as a place constantly consumed by fire, smoke, and burning sulfur. It's a place of utter darkness with the stench of burning flesh, and the sounds of weeping and gnashing teeth.
- Hell was not created for mankind. It was created for Lucifer and his band of angels. The only way that individuals (human) will find themselves dwelling in hell for all eternity is if they make a contentious deliberate decision to live their life without God and reject the work Jesus did on the cross. This rejection will cause them to die in their sins and be eternally separated from God. This is the only way to make HELL their eternal destination.

Heaven

- Heaven is described as a place of great beauty and color. It is the dwelling place of God, whose glory illuminates the city (there is no need for the sun).
- Heaven is the place God has provided for His creation (mankind) to live with Him eternally.
- Heaven is the eternal dwelling place of God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit, along with the two-thirds of the angels who did not follow after their fallen comrade.

- Heaven is also the eternal dwelling place for those who love God with all their heart, soul, and mind. It is the reward for those who have made a conscious and deliberate decision to choose life with God, and accept the free gift of salvation (the gift which Jesus died to make this opportunity a reality).
- The only way to make heaven your eternal destination is to repent of your sin; accept and believe that Jesus died on the cross to pay a debt that you could not pay, and live daily for Him. It's a conscious decision, one that we all must make!

The Fall of Man...The Love of God

The Fall of Man

God gave man the ability to make decisions...to choose between right and wrong; good and evil. With the ability of choice given to him, man (Adam & Eve) made the decision to disobey God's command (Genesis 2). This act of disobedience set the precedence for the future of mankind and introduced sin into the world.

The Love of Father God

Even though man turned away from God, He (God) still wanted to have fellowship with him (man). God provided a way for man to live in fellowship with Him on earth and in Heaven. He sacrificed His one and only Son, Jesus Christ, thus providing an avenue in which mankind could be restored to a right relationship with Him.

Understanding the Role of Jesus, God's Provision
